Senior Quotes - <u>Due Date: Wednesday, September 30th, 2020</u>

- Quotes should be submitted via a Google Form that will be sent out at the beginning of the school year.
- Quotes **MUST** be school appropriate.
- Please be mindful in choosing a quote. This will be printed in the book forever and available for generations to see in the JCB and Phoenix Public Libraries.
- Quotes should be positive and represent a positive attribute about yourself.
- Please think about whether the quote will make your parents, teachers, grandparents, & future children proud.
- Questionable quotes will be submitted to the principal/superintendent for final approval. The yearbook staff reserves the right to deny publishing senior quotes.
